(Visit www.flagfootballwc.com for explanation of CEP). ***Some tournaments will offer 8-Man Ineligible so check the details for each event.***

WC QUALIFYING: Teams will be placed in the divisions at the World Championships in Orlando, FL based on their performance on the circuit (Win/Loss record, Points and Tournament Wins). Top percentage of teams will compete in the Pro Division, while the other teams will be placed in Open. *Check the Ineligible section of the MCFFU website for details on WC Qualifications.*

BIDS: Any bid(s) awarded to the World Championships for any team is paid by the tournament director/organization – *All bids are optional and are to the discretion of the tournament director(s).*

NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS: NC events will award double points and will include Dallas (TX), VA Beach (VA), Mercer County (NJ) and St. Louis (MO).

Tournaments may still be added to the **World Championship Circuit**; however approval will depend on both time and location as the circuit is spaced out enough in an attempt to reduce regional conflicts with other sanctioned events.
